What is a digital footprint? (Every day is picture day)

Passive

Search history

Things others post

You might not know it's there

Active Intentional sharing Social media updates

Your digital footprint includes:

Every <u>social media profile</u> you've ever created (even if you think it's private)

- Every comment or picture you've posted or been mentioned in
- Online discussions you've participated in or online groups you've joined
- Your online footprint exists even if you're not on

Doesit matter? Maybe...

51% of employers have passed on employee because of Inappropriate photos or information Negative comments about fellow student/employee Poor communication skills

40% college admissions officers visit applicants social media

Audit your footprint

5 ways colleges search for you online

Start with Google

First name and last name

No quotes says either the first or last name in any order

"first name + last name" (in quotes)

Quotes make the search specify that first name and last name in order with a space between\

"first name + Last Name" + City

"first + last" + School

"first + middle + last+

Looking for any public records on you

"email address"

You're a good person and a great friend – and you want your social media presence to reflect this . . .


