




What is Age of Consent? What does that mean?

Age of consent – the age in which a person can legally provide consent to sex.

Anyone younger than the age of consent is legally not considered able to provide a yes to sex and therefore any sexual acts with a person under the age of consent immediately are considered assault.






Confidential

 To keep from others. Specifically, keep information from others as a trusted source.





Provider-Patient Privilege

• A healthcare provider not sharing medical information about their patient without their permission. The level of privilege varies state to state on what a healthcare provider can keep confidential when treating someone under the age of 18.
