

Like nearly every district in Washington, we rely on levies to provide essential funding for programs not fully funded by our state. We have an operations and technology levy on the upcoming special election ballot on Feb. 13, 2024. These levies would replace two voter-approved levies from 2020 that will expire soon. As a reminder to voters, we use the easy-to-remember adage “bonds are for building and levies are for learning.” These replacement levies pay for nearly **25 percent** of the cost of educational services that the state does not adequately fund.

Operations Levy

The replacement technology levy pays for:

School modernization and safety enhancements:
security cameras, door locking systems

School wired/wireless networks

Adaptive technologies and devices for children with special needs

Computers, software, and digital curriculum licensing
