Design Goals and Sample Descriptions

1. This elementary is a neighborhood school

This school is an anchor to the community that includes unique design features that distinguish it as a forward thinking place of learning while maintaining harmony within the surrounding neighborhood. Design will include welcoming elements and provides multi-functional, multi-cultural and seasonally appropriate spaces.

2. Provide a quality teaching and learning environment

Alderwood Elementary school supports high quality instruction for every student, every day, in every classroom, and is a safe, welcoming, flexible, collaborative space designed for the whole child.

3. The design supports the educational goals of the school and the district

Alderwood Elementary School supports students, families, staff, and the community, reaching outcomes of the Bellingham Promise through spaces that support quality instruction, collaboration and communication.

4. The school supports collaborative learning and facilitates communication

Alderwood Elementary School is a place where students and the community members have spaces both large and small to accommodate collaborative learning and communication with the diverse community of Alderwood. Consideration is given to support students and families who speak multiple languages.

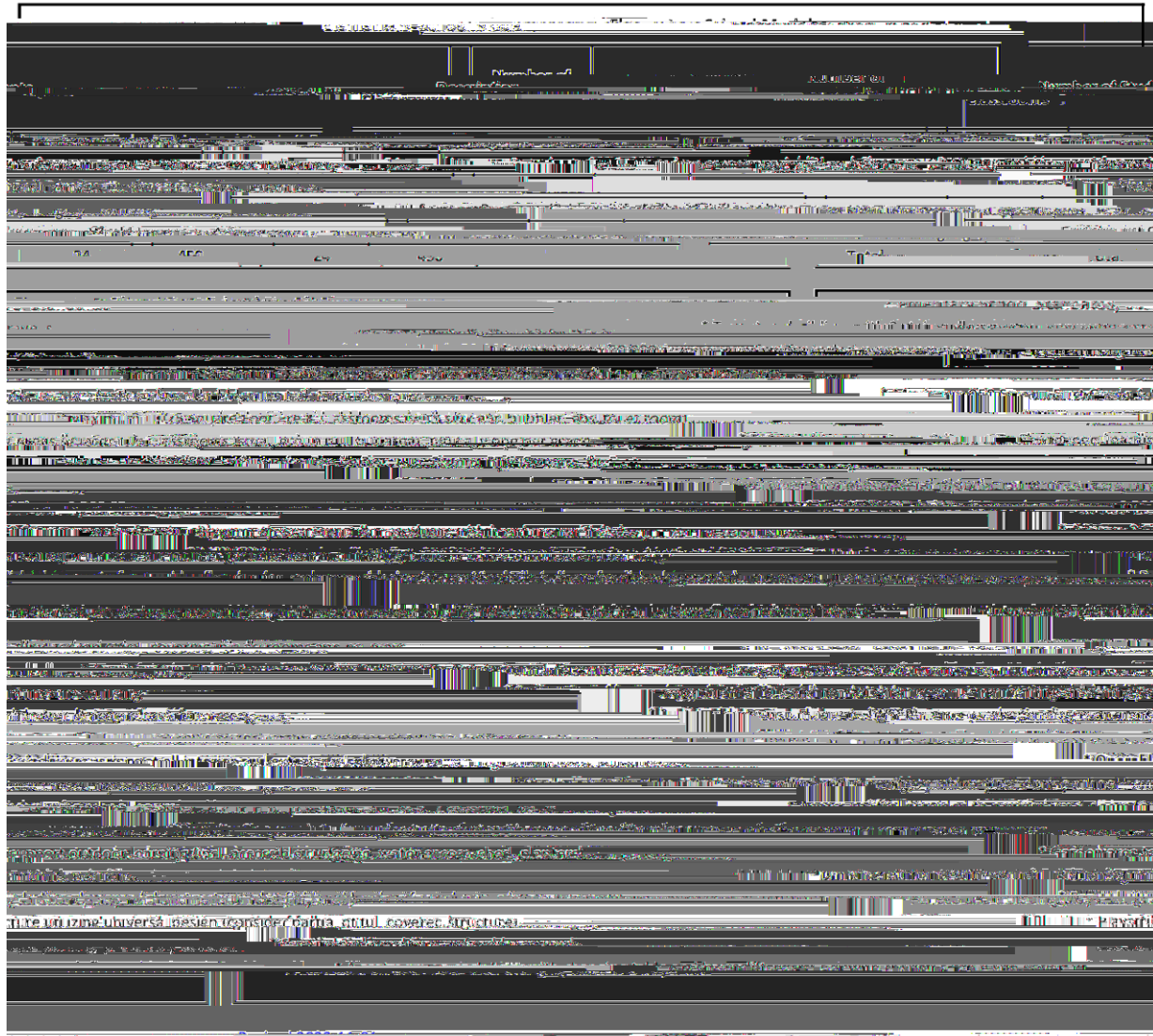

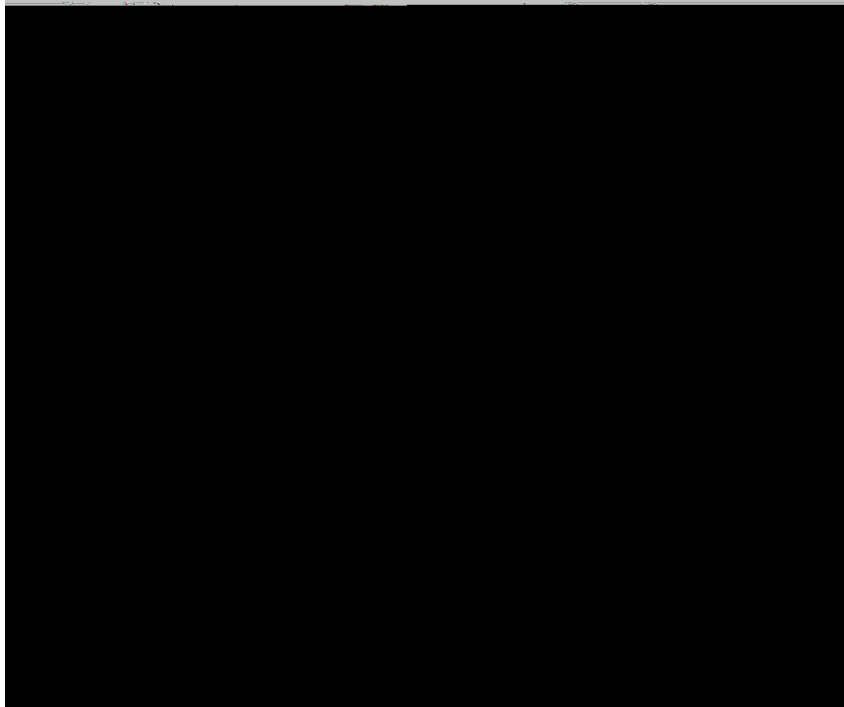
