# What is Age of Consent? What does that mean?

Age of consent – the age in which a person can legally provide consent to sex.

Anyone younger than the age of consent is legally not considered able to provide a yes to sex and therefore any sexual acts with a person under the age of consent immediately are considered assault.



# Confidential

- To keep from others. Specifically, keep information from others as a trusted source.



# Provider-Patient Privilege

- A healthcare provider not sharing medical information about their patient without their permission. The level of privilege varies state to state on what a healthcare provider can keep confidential when treating someone under the age of 18.



# Sexting

- Sending OR receiving sexually explicit



# Child Pornography

- Sexually explicit image of any person under the age of 18 years old.





# Safe Haven

law that allows a parent to surrender a child within a specific time frame to a trusted adult in a specific location ~~and~~ ex:



# Sex Trafficking

- When a person is forced to have sex with others through acts of intimidation or coercion.



# Federal Laws on Age of Consent

- Provide some guidelines for the states
- The range suggested by the federal government is:

No age of consent shall be below the age of 12 or above the age of 18.



# Federal Laws on Confidentiality – Healthcare

- For adults, or people over the age of 18  
HIPAA offers a blanket protection that  
healthcare providers are not to discuss their  
patient's information without their approval.
- For minors, or people under the age of 18,
